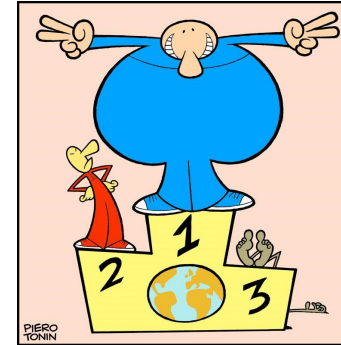

China

The people of China are disappointed that only 80% of the population were able to work and ask that the government improves their lives with greater access to health care, education, cultural centers, sanitation and increased jobs. They are marching in the streets, demanding more jobs, and are starting violent protests if the government does not start getting their economy working. **3 of your military must stay at home to deal with the violent protests.**

Japan

The people of Japan are worried that with the dissolution of the military treaty and Japan's lack of military they are open to an invasion by another country. They are also very concerned that Japan is sitting on well over a million dollars of cash reserves. They demand that the government spend the money to improve their lives, and solve their problems. Japan is set to have a 1,000,000 person shortfall in the working population. The influx of 40,000 refugees is not enough to stop the lack of workers in the country. **Return 1 industry (yellow pin) from your country to the world bank.**

Africa

They are pleased that they were all able to work, but feel they should have more access to health care, education, cultural centers, sanitation. The lack of food in Africa has led to a mass exodus of people from the northern part of Africa.

Greenland and Iceland

The latest UNEC report has Greenland scientist concerned as they realize that the poles will be affected faster than the rest of the world. Greenland's glaciers are shrinking and it is projected that they will be lost in the coming years if nothing is done to mitigate the impending climate change. **Return 1 blue pin from your country as a glacier has dried up and was lost due to the accelerated melting caused by global warming.** This will be the ongoing trend if nothing is done to change global CO2 levels.

South and South East Asia

The people of the South and South East Asia are happy as their entire population was able to work last year. They are now thinking they would like a better quality of life and are demanding greater access to health care, education, cultural centers, sanitation and increased jobs. Brazil
